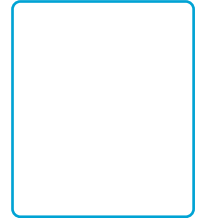

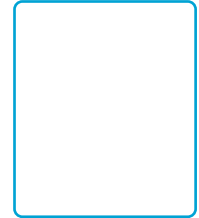

Important instructions for depositing the Fee

1. The fee is collected on quarterly basis. The school will not send reminders for fee schedule
2. The last day for depositing the fee without fine will be 10th of every Fee collection month. (Ref to Pg no. 4)
3. After last day of the fee collection month, fee will be collected with a fine of Rs.20/-per day.
4. In case the fee is not deposited during the allotted period, the name of the student may be struck off. Re-admission in the school will depend on availability of seats.
5. The complete fee amount mentioned in the fee slip should be deposited.No partial payment will be entertained.
6. Transport facility can be availed from beginning of the session only.Those who want to avail school transport will have to fill a separate application form with details of address,route number and one photograph of the student.
7. In case of loss of receipt book,thenew receipt book can be obtained from the school on payment of Rs.20/-.
8. FEES ONCE PAID WILL NOT BE REFUNDABLE.
9. Parents should preserve the fee receipt and produce it on demand by the school.
10. In case a cheque is dishonored, a fine of Rs.500/- will have to be paid along with the Fee. In future cheque will not be accepted for the same student.
11. One month advance information is required for issue of transfer certificate & withdrawal of transport facility else the fee for month will have to be paid.
12. School's transportation fee will be charged for 12 months (complete academic session) for those who avail school's transport facility.

Attendance and withdrawal rules

1. Notice of one Month excluding holidays should be given in prior. Leave/leaves must be sanctioned in advance by the class teacher & in case of long leaves it must be sanctioned by Principal.
2. All the days of events and PTM will be counted.
3. It is mandatory to join PTM.
4. In case the student suffers from any infectious disease, he/she must not join the school. Once the child recovers, he/she will only be allowed with a fitness certificate from the Doctor who treated the child. It is also important to inform the school immediately.
5. All are expected to attend classes on the opening day of school after vacation. Absence for more than five days after vacation renders the student to have his/her name struck-off from the school rolls.
6. If a student absents himself/herself from the school without information for more than 10 consecutive days, his/her name is liable to be struck-off from the rolls. Re-admission will be allowed on payment of fresh admission fee.
7. Minimum 75% attendance is mandatory as per CBSE Bye-laws failing which the student will not be allowed to give Exam.
8. No short leave will be provided to students, during working hours.

Applying for school leaving certificate

1. A month's notice excluding holidays is to be given before the withdrawal of the pupil or one month's fee will be charged.
2. In the case of long absence, if the absent pupil's name is carried forward to the next month, fee shall be charged for that month.
3. No school leaving certificate will be given until all due to the school have been paid in full or satisfactorily arranged for.
4. The school leaving certificate will be issued to parent only. In case anybody else from the family needs to collect it, he/she must carry an authority letter from the parents.
5. In case of withdrawal of a student, it should be made known to the Principal in writing, one calendar month in advance or else one month's fee will be charged.

For parents to note

Dear Parents

As we are all determined to help our children develop the various aspects of their personality, both **THE TEACHERS AND THE PARENTS** have to work together in this process of their education.

1. Carrying expensive articles like **MOBILE PHONES**, gold ornaments and watches etc., are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** in school. If any of these articles is confiscated from a student, it will not be returned. In case of loss/theft of any article the school will not be responsible.
2. A strict action will be taken against the uniform defaulters.
3. All students must reach school before ten minutes to the school timings. Those who are found coming late to school will be sent back home. Entry to school is not permissible after the main gate closes at 7:30am in summer, 8:30am in winters.
4. Students must observe polite standards wherever they go. The students are the brand ambassadors of the school. They should greet their teachers/elders visitors when they meet them and must be humble to their junior students. Bullying and use of foul language is prohibited and is a punishable offence as per school rules.
5. As the **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION IS ENGLISH** children should be helped to follow lessons easily and intelligently by a certain amount of regular conversation in English at home. **IN THE SCHOOL CAMPUS STUDENTS MUST TALK IN ENGLISH WITH EACH OTHER.**
6. The student's are not allowed to drive four wheeler or two wheeler, till the licence is received.

Important

1. The Student profile form in the 'School Almanac' must be filled correctly and promptly.
2. Any change in address or telephone number must be communicated immediately to the school office.
3. Children must wear their school identity card everyday to ensure their safety.

4. Children must bring the almanac to school everyday which can be used by parents as well as teachers to convey any information or note the assignments given by teachers.
5. All parents must be aware about school ERP in case of any issue, the front desk may be connected.
6. Parents must check the almanac everyday for any note. The same should be acknowledged by the parents by affixing their signature.
7. Label all the note books, books, water bottle, crayons, school bags etc. of your child.
8. Do help your child to memorize his/her full name, school name he/she is studying in, class teacher's name, bus route number and residence telephone numbers.(for toddler)
9. Hand writing must be focused.
10. The child should be given a Time-Table at home and should be encouraged to observe regular study habits.
11. He/she should also be helped to decorate the corner of the house given to him/her as his/her STUDY CORNER with charts and other educational material.
12. Self-help for work and study should be encouraged. He/she should be taught to keep the room tidy, make his/her own bed, polish his/her own shoes, carry his/her own bag etc. The formation of such habits in early life, inculcates in the student, dignity of work, which is a fundamental personal virtue necessary for a successful career in life.
13. Parents must see that the child organizes his/her uniform and bag according to the time table, the day prior.
14. Parents must ensure the punctuality of the child.
15. Every student must take part in sports & other school activities.
16. The Discipline Committee comprising senior students and a Teacher Incharge checks students for behavior, punctuality, uniform etc.
17. Students must reach school on time atleast five minutes before the first bell time.
18. Absenting oneself without a proper Leave Application will be treated as Absent.
19. A child is not allowed to go home once he comes to school, no half day leave is permitted, except emergency.
20. If, for a serious reason, a child is to be taken home the parents must apply in writing. All exemptions/permissions etc must be sought from the Principal.
21. A student will not be sent home with any other person unless he/she produces a letter of authority from the parents with photograph of concerned person.
22. Parents should abstain from meeting teachers during school hours. If the parents would like to meet any of the teachers, they must seek an appointment or visit the school on the dates printed in the planner when the teachers are available in the school for consultation.

23. Parents may meet the teachers by asking for an appointment with the teacher through the student's almanac.
24. In case the parent wish to pick up the student from school who uses the school transportation, the parents will have to take the out pass signed by the Principal.

Disciplinary measures

1. Students should take care of school property. They should not write or sketch on the desks, chairs, walls or doors of the school nor should they damage the property of others. Any damage done to school property must be paid by the offender.
2. The school is not responsible, for any loss of money or articles. Money should not be lent or borrowed nor articles exchanged.
3. Students are not allowed to go to their friends' homes for birthday parties etc. directly from school.
4. In case of any breach of conduct the student will be expelled from school without any Warning.
5. Due to safety reasons, lunch packs delivered at the gate, will neither be accepted nor sent across to the students.
6. A student who misbehaves in the school bus will be debarred from using the same.
7. Students involved in fights and those found bunking classes will be suspended for 15 days.
8. Students without license must not drive any two wheeler or four wheeler. If noticed, vehicles will be towed away to the nearest police station.
9. **EXPULSION:** Student found guilty of misconduct can be expelled as per rules of Delhi School Education Act or according to any other relevant legal provision or code of conduct.

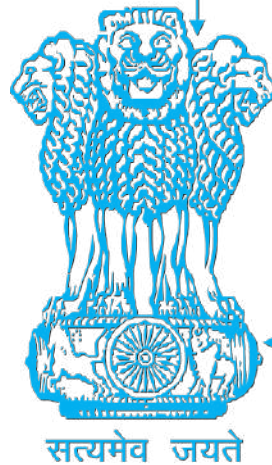
International Pledge

National Emblem

Carved out of a single block of polished sandstone, the Capital is crowned by the Wheel of the Law (Dharma Chakra). The wheel appears in relief in the centre of the abacus with a bull on right and a horse on left and the outlines of other wheels on extreme right and left. The bell-shaped lotus has been omitted.

The state emblem is an adaptation from Sarnath Lion Capital of Ashoka. In the original, there are four lions, standing back to back, in the state emblem, adopted by the Government of India on 26 January 1950, only three lions are visible, the fourth being hidden from view.



The word Satyameva Jayate from Mundaka Upanishad, meaning 'Truth Alone Triumphs', are inscribed below the abacus in Devanagari script.

Mounted on an abacus with a frieze carrying sculptures in high relief of an elephant, a galloping horse, a bull and a lion separated by intervening wheels over a bell-shaped lotus.
